Club Auction and Adopt-A-Daylily Meeting Thursday May 11, 2017.

Please see the following list of cultivars which will be available through a live bidding process at the meeting. A list below contains the cultivars which will be dug and divided from the GBBG daylily beds from the May 9 dig and divide. These cultivars, including personal garden cultivars will be offered at half off the list price. This is a great way to build your collection, purchasing items at 50% off of regular prices. A credit card reader will be available for those who prefer to use for purchases. Personal checks and cash are also accepted.

Here is the list of cultivars offered from the 2017 GBBG beds:

- "Bang Bang" (Bremer 2011),
- "Chick Flick" (Douglas-H 2011),
- "Deal or No Deal" (Douglas -C 2011),
- "Horse Pen Creek" (Tanner-G 2011),
- "Love Is Enough" (Douglas-C 2011),
- "Peach Bombshell" (Bremer 2009),
- "River Lore" (Mason-M 2009),
- "Whiskey Rebellion" (Mason-M 2009).

Photos and descriptions will be available at the auction. You are also welcome to research on the internet prior to the meeting.

Club members are also encouraged to review your personal collections, divide and provide cultivars for the auction if you are able to do so. No more than 2-3 double fans per cultivar, please. If your gardens have clumps of daylilies (8 or more fans), and you would like to share the cultivar with a club member(s) for purchase, please split and prepare as bare root, bagged and tagged (labeled) and bring with you the evening of the auction May 11. Potted plants are usually not the best option, only for cleanliness issues. If you can afford to donate

some of your cultivars for the club auction, please contact Terry Vertz so we can organize the auction to eliminate idle time during the auction. Remember, if you donate, keep track of your time spent in your gardens digging and dividing. You will earn (2) Bad Buck dollars for every hour spent in your personal gardens.

ADOPT A DAYLILY PROGRAM

Adopt a daylily program is a partnership with the Bad Buds in which you can adopt a plant and grow it to the point of five or more fans. At this point, the grower may keep two fans for your gardens from the clump and donate the remaining fans back to the club (a typical growing time is 2-3 years to develop additional fans for division). If you are a holder of such plant(s), please review and assess if a division of the cultivar is possible. Excess fans returned will be planted back into the GBBG daylily display beds for regeneration or auctioned off. Some plants are slow to increase and may not be ready for division, please inform Terry Vertz if this applies to you.

Adoption parent Eligibility:

To be qualified in this year's drawing:

- You must have been a club member for a minimum of (1) year.
- Have never won an Adopt -A-Daylily.
- Have previously won and have returned fans or will be returning fans at the May 11, 2017 auction.
- Had an adoption that did not survive.

Note, two people under the same membership are each eligible to receive an adoption plant.

Current records show the following club members are listed to return Adopt-A-Daylily cultivars for 2017. If your name appears on this list please review the clump and decide if division is warranted. If so, please divide (keep 2 fans for yourself) and bring to the May 11 Auction meeting. Please contact Terry Vertz if you are returning fans or are going to hold over another year to increase clump size.
