- Tuesday May 7th 3:30 pm, we will be having our annual cleanup, fertilize, mulch, dig and divide for the club auction/meeting. GBBG/BAD Buds Daylily display beds Bed cleanup, fertilize and mulch plus dig and divide for the auction. Rain date Wednesday May 8th. Remember, you earn (2) Bad Bucks per hour worked which can be used at the auction for purchases. Please bring any available weeding, digging and/or dividing tools you may have for use. Light snacks and water will be provided. As many hands make light work, please attend to help if you can.
- If you plan to dig from your own collection for the auction, please prepare as bare root double fans in a single bag which is tagged. The information should contain : name of hybridizer, name of plant, height, size of bloom, color, early - mid - or late, and bud count if possible. You may email the names of your selections to Terry Vertz at Maverty@att.net if you will be digging from your own gardens.
- Thursday May 9th 6:00 pm GBBG Visitor's Center - short meeting followed by annual auction and adopt-a-daylily drawing.

ADOPT A PLANT

Please see the attachment which lists the club member and the cultivar due back to the club. If your name appears and you are able to dig the plant and provide fans back to the club on Thursday May 9th, please do so. Remember to keep (2) fans for your gardens and return the others you have prepared already bagged and tagged. If the fans are young and tender and risk damage you will have to use your judgement whether to dig or leave for next year's return, please report the status of your cultivar if you are unable to return fans at Thursday's meeting. This may be the case as we have had a delayed growing season at the start. If you plan to dig for the adopt - a - plant program, please contact Terry Vertz so the club can decide if any fans will be returned back into the GBBG gardens.
